

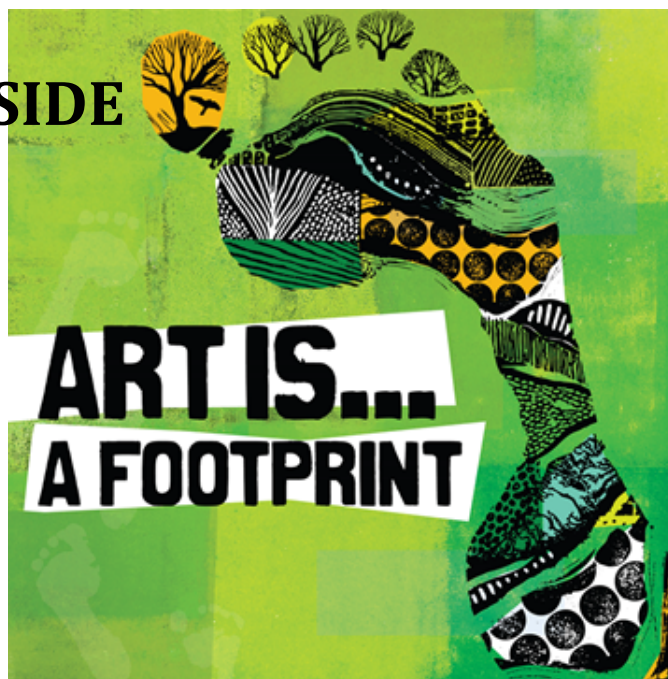
# GALLERIES ON THE SIDE EXHIBITION GUIDE


*We recognise the important and ongoing place that all Indigenous people hold in our community.*






